TRANSPONDERS

S.N.O.R.E., along with other race organizations, uses transponders to automate the task of timing and scoring races.

Transponders work best if mounted on the outside of the driver's side A-frame or on the netting. Transponder should be mounted towards the top of the vehicle. Transponders can not be covered, especially by metal, and must be exposed to allow proper transmission and readability.

<u>Do Not use metal hose clamps or other metal clamps</u> to secure the transponder as the metal will reduce the transponder's effectiveness. Velcro or zip ties have worked well to secure transponders.
