 - \$1,500 Class 1 Patrick's Signs bonus
- Blade – Saturday of course marking
- Look at foregoing NHP if we can't have spectators at the Dyke Jump.
- Qualifying
 - Same as normal
 - 15 cars with a deposit to qualify
 - Course will be the same as last year
 - Class 9 and 5/1600 Qualifying together
